Getting to Camp

Please arrive at camp at your scheduled time. Directions and maps to camp may be found on the camp website at www.upbible.org. The main entrance is at the intersection of Bible Camp Drive and Skihill road. There is parking along the driveway, and the camp office will be on your left. One of our instructors will meet you at the office porch.

Acknowledgment of Risk Forms

No one will be allowed to participate without a completed Acknowledgment of Risk form. Additional copies may be downloaded from the Adventure Challenge page at www.upbible.org. Participants should complete these forms (participants under 18 must also obtain a parent's signature) and return them to the group leader. The group leader should be ready to present the Acknowledgment of Risk forms upon arrival to camp on the day of your event so that we can review them for any health or safety concerns prior to your activity.

Clothing & Weather

Participants must wear closed-toe shoes and should wear shirts that can be tucked in. Dress for the weather, but avoid bulky clothing. We can run the challenge course in cold weather or light rain, but in the case of high winds, heavy rain or snow, or icy conditions, we will have to reschedule your activity.

Payment

Payment by cash or check is due upon arrival to camp on the day of your activity. Make checks out to U.P. Bible Camp. A single check is preferred. If you must pay with more than one check, please collect funds from everyone in your group so you can present the total amount due at registration.
