CAMP FEE DUE: This is to be paid upon arrival at camp. Please make check payable to U.P. Bible Camp, U.S. funds

REGISTRATION FEE: The registration fee you have paid is additional to the camp fee and is refundable only if application is canceled at least three weeks prior to the camp period.

ARRIVAL TIMES: Arrival day is Saturday. If you are dropping your child off at camp, please plan to arrive around 11:30 a.m. The lunch meal will be served after the bus arrives around 12:30.

DEPARTURE TIMES: Departure day is Saturday: Buses leave camp by 9:00 a.m. If you are planning on picking your child up at camp, please arrive at 9:00 a.m., and sign your child out at the office porch.

HEALTH FORM: A doctor's examination is not required. A medical form from the Camp is enclosed for parents to complete and sign. Please fill out the immunization section carefully. *The medical form must be submitted upon arrival to camp or mailed in advance.*

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP: Below are listed some recommended items. Campers should bring enough clothing to last the entire period since laundry service is not available. *The camper's name should be plainly marked on each article with a laundry pen or name tapes.*

MISPLACED CLOTHING: Every season some good clothing is left behind at camp. Call camp immediately if you would like us to arrange to send it home with someone. Unclaimed items will be kept until the following season, and then given to needy families.

CABIN ASSIGNMENT: Campers are generally grouped by age. Unless you have requested a cabin mate in advance, please do not ask to have campers transferred after arrival.

INSURANCE BENEFITS: All campers are covered by partial medical expense insurance. Travel time is covered up to 48 hours prior to and 48 hours after camp.

REGULATIONS: The use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, and drugs, is prohibited. The breaking of the rule is considered a serious offense, and parents will be notified and appropriate action taken. No gum allowed at camp. Campers are not permitted to spend time away from the camp grounds without the Directors knowledge and consent.

VISITORS: Visitors are welcome to tour the camp facilities at any time, after checking in at the office. Parents and friends of campers, however, are requested not to disturb the routine of camp and place a burden on those whose parents and friends are unable to visit. Part of the value of camp to a youngster is to learn to be content away from home and family.

TELEPHONE CALLS: Parents are advised to call campers only in case of emergency. Campers must obtain permission to make long distance calls from camp. The camp telephone number is: 906-346-6165
